New IEP Reporting Guidelines for Elementary

The reporting periods for your child's IEP have changed based on recommendations from the provincial Special Education Committee.

Effective September 2017, your child's IEP will be reviewed and updated within the first 30 instructional days of school, with the Term 1 report card in January and the Term 2 report card in June.

As always, we welcome communication and conversation about your child's progress, on-going achievement of learning skills, work habits and curriculum expectations at any time.

School Hours at Elgin Avenue

All elementary schools in The Grand Erie District School Board operate on a Balanced Day Schedule. The school day is organized in to three instructional blocks and two 40 minute nutritional breaks.

The school playground is supervised from 8:30 a.m.-3:10 p.m. daily. Students should not arrive at school prior to 8:30 a.m.

All students must remain on school property unless they have parent permission. Students are asked to remain on school property for the First Nutrition break (10:20-11:00). Those who have permission to leave the property for lunch will do so on the second nutrition break (12:40-1:20pm).

We expect that all students will display good manners and be respectful of each other during the Nutrition/Fitness breaks. Students must follow lunchroom routines under the supervision of school staff.
