## 4. Standing Agenda Items

### 4.1 Principal's Update

(a) Traffic Control

- New lines painted outside school entrances and in parking lot; concerns about pedestrians and cars mingling
- Spoken to the county, OPP and board personnel to determine ways to increase safety: will have more signs once approved by the county
- OPP Ken Johnson will be out and about to help increase safety
- 2 new handicapped parking spaces, designated kiss and ride and bus spots
- Has been completed at other schools with good reviews
- Will not be putting in sidewalks due to drainage issues
- Teena mentioned sidewalks had been discussed many years ago and the issues are the same
- Intermediate students cut across the road and are walking up and down the middle
- Thadeus reported he chose the most economical option for right now
- Danna suggested a one way street during drop off and pick up hours
(b) Temporary Staffing:
- Will have 1.0 FTE EA for 7 days and then 0.5 FTE EA for 10 days to then be reviewed at the end of the month to determine if needs are being met.
- Reasons to receive an EA: Physical, toileting, transitioning, behavioural needs, safety
- If school is going to receive a permanent EA increase need to go through this process
