- "Raise Some Dough Today"
- Danna and Amy to run this event

- Simple to order online through Lunch Box
- A volunteer needs to be at the school to handout the pitas, is not a lot of work

- 30 Minute game based sessions

- Volunteers are trained by the program
- Runs for 10 weeks and starts Mid-October
- Four streams are addressed within the program: Letters, Sounds, Words, Building Words
- Video link to be put on the Facebook school page and Wendy will have a table at the Meet the Teacher event
- Approximately 8 students were helped last school year
