# 1. Principal Update:

      - a. Evidence leads to possibility of someone having a master key and getting in
      - b. Ms. Shay is working with facility services to work on making sure the building is secure

      - d. Discussed possibility of installing cameras but they are expensive and don't tend to provide much information during an incident
      - e. Ms. Shay will inquire about police response for motion sensor activation at the school

- iii. Graduation \$501 held over from last year....need to clear up misunderstanding about whether we need to give them this year's \$500 too...will look to October minutes for what we discussed
