We are well underway to a great school year.



MATH: Students will be completing the unit on Place Value, demonstrating an understanding of place value in whole numbers from 1 to 100 000 and writing them in a variety of ways.

Standard Form: 987 354, Expanded Form: 900 000 + 80 000 + 7 000 + 300 + 50 + 4 and

Written Form: Nine hundred eighty-seven thousand three hundred fifty-four

Adding & Subtracting large numbers, as well as solving problems.

We will start a unit on Number Patterns. Students will be expected to identify, extend, and, and create patterns, as well as use these patterns to solve problems.

LITERACY: Students have been listening to a novel, *The Fourteenth Goldfish*. Throughout the novel, students are encouraged to listen, demonstrate comprehension, and respond appropriately to discussion questions related to the story. This month students will use stated and implied ideas in texts to make inferences and construct meaning and summarize their reading. In Writing, students will generate, gather, and organize ideas and information to write for an intended purpose and audience, through a poetry and opinion writing. Students have been given a book report assignment which will focus on summarizing and defining the main character in a story.

SOCIAL STUDIES: Students have been working on recognizing the provinces, territories and their capitals. We will be starting to look at the history of Canada by studying Early Explorers and the First Peoples of Canada.
