What are we learning about in Grade 3/4?

Math → We are continuing to practice counting forwards and backwards by 2's, 3's, 5's, 10's to 200. We have just finished up our Number Sense where we were learning how to represent numbers to 1000 (Grade 3) and 10 000 (Grade 4). Final unit marks will be coming home next week. Our new math focus is on Patterning. We are looking at how a pattern repeats itself, finding the core of the pattern and determining the pattern rule when working with numbers.

Language → Our focus in Language will be on Re-tell, looking specifically at characters, setting, beginning, middle and end. In writing, we will be working towards adding descriptive details to our writing (use of adjectives) and learning how to write a short story. Students will be expected to create a setting, characters, problem and a solution.

Science → The grade 3 students are currently in the middle of learning about the importance of 'Plants and Soil.' In grade 4, their focus is on 'Animal Habitats'.

Social Studies → This subject will be starting sometime in November.

Health → Our focus is on 'Healthy Eating' and Canada's Food Guide.
