# **Raz-Kids**

Raz-Kids is coming! This fun, interactive online reading website is a great way to get kids excited about reading with access to lots of levelled books with incentives built in to keep them motivated. Once I receive our login information, I will be able to set up accounts for students. I will put each child's login on the inside of their agenda cover for easy access.

# **Curriculum Connection**

Language: Our literacy centres are up and running! The students are focused on letter/sound associations and words they know (or can find) in their writing. Reading is taking place at the listening centre, during Independent and Buddy reading and our "travelling readers" visit the office and other teachers to show off their reading skills with our Poem Books. Introducing reading strategies will be a focus this month. (You can find a copy of these in your child's book bag).

**WOW words** (Words of the Week) begin! Please check your child's agenda on Mondays and practice spelling the words together for a few minutes each day. There will be a quiz each Friday!

Math: We are winding up our numeracy unit. We have been composing and decomposing numbers. The students really enjoyed using Base 10 materials to create really big numbers! We even tried our first "MART" (math + art) project. We will be moving on to sorting items by their attributes and then patterning!

Social Studies/Science: Big Idea: The Global Community. Grade 2 has been exploring different types of communities and will begin comparing their lives with the lives of kids from around the world. Grade 1 is joining Mrs. Metcalfe's class. They are learning about community helpers.

**Art**: We have been experimenting with line. Colour and Space are up next!
