EARLY SCHOOL CLOSURE PROCEDURES

Our school procedures for early school closure are as follows:

- If our internet is working, a voicemail/email will be forwarded to all parents and/or guardians to inform you about the closure.
- If our internet is not working, the staff will be using their personal or school phones to contact families.
- Students with older siblings will be sent home on their regular bus. Students who have permission to walk will be sent home. Instructions as per your emergency forms will be followed.

IMPORTANT NOTE

- <u>Younger students</u> who do not have any older siblings in the school will be contacted first. Parents/guardians of younger students MUST contact the school immediately after receiving notification from the school so arrangements can me made for their pick-up.
- If you have any questions, special circumstances or need further clarification, please contact the school.

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Please note that in the case of inclement weather if school buses are cancelled in a particular zone, the schools in that zone will be closed to all staff and stu-



dents. **We are in ZONE 3.** Please listen to the radio or check the Board' s website at www.granderie.ca to find out whether the buses are cancelled and schools are closed. If the school buses have not been cancelled, the school will remain open and classes will proceed as usual.

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PIANO LESSONS AT GLEN MORRIS SCHOOL

Under the Education Act, students are allowed to be dismissed from school up to 2 hours per week for music enrichment. This could include private music lessons at school or where parents pick up their child and bring them to music lessons at an outside location. At Glen Morris School, we feel that by having private piano lessons at school, it will benefit students (and parents), who would like their child (ren) to be involved in music.
