Happy New Year and welcome back! The first week has been filled with stories about everyone's adventures. As we transition back to school, we also return to familiar routines and learning opportunities.

Letter of the Week: we continue to learn all about letters, sounds, and how they combine together to make words. We remind you to help your child find an item from home that begins with the letter of the week. These items are shared during our sharing circle on the first day of the school week. The students are eager and proud to draw their object from home on our letter charts which are displayed in our room all year.

Journals: students continue to add journal entries each week. Students are focusing on drawing detailed pictures that make sense to the reader. Students are also learning how to tell a story about what is happening in their picture. SK students continue to print their own sentence starters by copying from a model. They are beginning to complete more of their sentence by sounding out words and using writing supports such as our word wall.

Math: students continue to explore a variety of math concepts during our Morning Meeting, Bucket Centres, and play. Students are currently very interested in patterning right now!
