## \$\$ Dollar Dice\$\$

This is a game we have been playing at school to help us develop our understanding of money to $\$ 1$. The students requested that I send a game card home so they could play the game at home with you! Great idea!

Objective: To be the first person to get EXACTLY \$1.00

Materials: One die (dice), and about 5 pennies, 5 nickels, 5 dimes and 5 quarters per player.

Rules: Take turns rolling the dice and collecting coins using the corresponding chart below. Example: If you roll a 2 you get a nickel.

| 1 | 2 | 3 | 4 | 5 | 6 |
| :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: | :---: |
| penny | nickel | dime | quarter | pick <br> any <br> coin | miss <br> your <br> turn |

Keep rolling until one player has a dollar. If you roll a number that puts you over a dollar you may not take that coin and must pass your turn. Keep rolling until you earn the exact amount.
