

February Curriculum Areas

LANGUAGE

Oral Communication: Oral retelling, reflecting, and relating from independent reading, small and large group discussions, and presenting an oral reading of a poem.

Reading: Home reading program, independent, shared, and guided reading. For February our reading activities as a class will focus on newspapers and the Olympics, but will still include a variety of fiction and non-fiction texts. We will also be working on making connections.

Writing: Journal entries, reading responses, Working with Words, and adding detail and description to our writing. The main focus for writing will be a newspaper article, learning to organize ideas before writing using an organizer, as well as, learning to take the information in an organizer and turn it into a small paragraph. Students will also complete writing responses to Olympic newspaper articles.

Media Literacy: We will be focusing on how we can help the environment. We will be looking at posters, ads, and videos about the environment. Students will then be creating a poster with an important message related to protecting the environment
