It has been extremely cold so please make sure your child is warm enough for recesses at school. If your child needs warmer items, please let me know and I will see if we have some warmer things to use.

Also please continue to have your child practice zipping their coats independently. We teach them to put mittens on last so they can use their hands to do them up!

Language/ Math: Don't forget to return reading folders each Monday to exchange new books! It is important to read with your child, try to make some time after dinner or before bed each night. Remember, the books sent home are not the only books you can record. Our Math activities will continue to focus on measurement. We have been using the scales and experimenting with weight. "The Hungry Thing". This cycle focuses a lot on rhyming and describing things. We have done a few describing activities already, ask your child if they remember what "The Hungry Thing" looks like.
