The successful candidates must report daily to the Facility Services Building located in Brantford and will perform work at all school board buildings or grounds within the City of Brantford as well as Brant, Haldimand and Norfolk Counties.

Qualifications:

- possess a minimum valid G2 license
- · able to work effectively in a team situation
- able to work efficiently and effectively with minimum supervision
- · possess good communication and interpersonal skills
- strong work ethic and ability to follow direction
- previous relevant work-related experience preferred
- currently attend or are planning to attend (i.e. in September, 2018) a post-secondary school
- must be available to work for the months of May to August, 2018
