The community-based awards for elementary and high school students in Grand Erie District School Board will be for students with barriers and disadvantages who do their best with enthusiasm, perseverance and positive attitudes.

The purpose of the awards is to acknowledge students who:

- (a) make significant positive contributions to their school community despite challenges;
- (b) overcome barriers and disadvantages to achieve marked recent improvement over past accomplishments;
- (c) excel academically, socially and/or physically in spite of health challenges;
- (d) consistently demonstrate positive attitudes and exemplary efforts;
- (e) are the "everyday heroes" who take care of others needing assistance.

This will be an annual award program and applications will be distributed to schools in April 2017. Annually, awards will be made to elementary school students and high school students.
