## Curriculum Update

In reading, we finished reading the novel The One and Only Ivan. What a great book! The entire class has agreed on how wonderful this book has been. While reading the book, we were working on answering reading comprehension questions using a three stage approach. 1. Use part of the question to start your answer. 2. Answer the question. 3. Use proof from the text to support your thinking. The students have done a very nice job of answering these kinds of questions and I have seen a lot of growth in several students in their quality of reading comprehension answers. Our next project is a Book Fair. Students will read a book of their choice and create a display that includes; Author Biography, Title, Problem, Solution, Character, Setting, Plot Summary, Personal Opinion and Mood. This is an at school project. The students will have plenty of class time to complete the work.

In writing, we will be learning how to write a book recommendation to go along with our Book Fair Projects.

In math, we are starting a unit on division. The students will develop strategies for dividing whole numbers. They will use mental math, estimation, manipulatives and paper/pencil calculations. We use division in many day to day situations. Encourage your child to practice basic division facts. Talk with your child about the strategies you use to recall these facts.
