## **Novel Study:**

The novel we recently started is called, "Holes" by Louis Sachar. We are using the computers and a program called Notebook within the Office365 to organize our Chapter Questions, Collaborate on some answers, and individual answer some questions related to the book. Using WordQ word prediction software students are able to complete answers, and with editing assistance they can polish their work to include proper capitalization, punctuation and make complete sentences. All of their work is available through their board email address in the class notebook entitled Breaking News Stories.

## Math:

Geometry is almost finished! We have examined 2D and 3D shapes and nets extensively and have most recently worked with tangrams to investigate shape movement as we head into translations and symmetry.
