- **Younger students** who do not have any older siblings in the school will be contacted first. **Parents/guardians of younger students MUST contact the school immediately** after receiving notification from the school so arrangements can be made for their pick-up.


Glen Morris Gives Back!

PIANO LESSONS AT GLEN MORRIS SCHOOL

Under the Education Act, students are allowed to be dismissed from school up to 2 hours per week for music enrichment. This could include private music lessons at school or where parents pick up their child and bring them to music lessons at an outside location. At Glen Morris School, we feel that by having private piano lessons at school, it will benefit students (and parents), who would like their child(ren) to be involved in music.
