



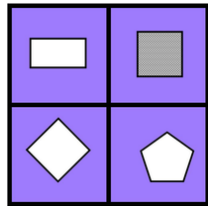

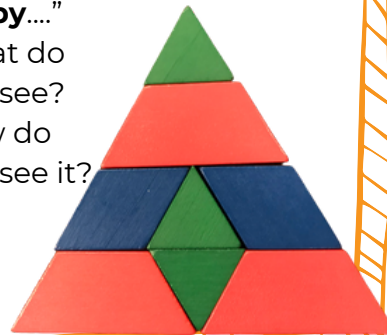

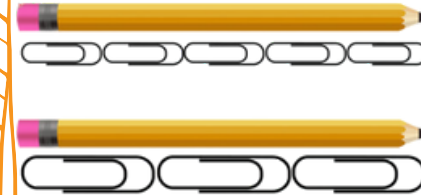


Write a List

Different? Share your reasons with someone.



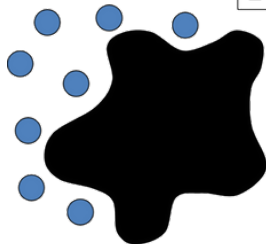
Read a Poem

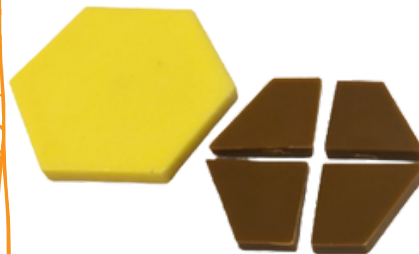


Play Guess My Word

Different?



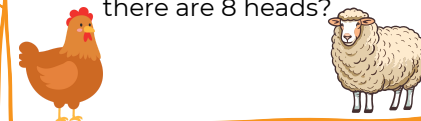
Write Instructions

Write a letter or card to a loved one. Deliver it or send it in the mail.

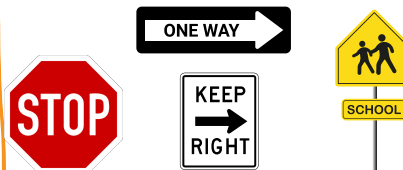

Speed limit signs

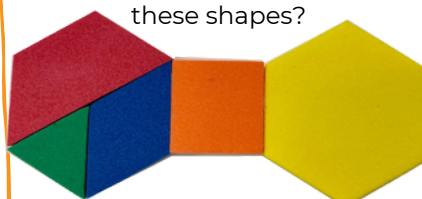


Read a Story
