## CURRICULUM CORNER


In Language, we have been learning about ideas and using our ideas to support our writing! We have also been reading Fiction stories and discussing the beginning, middle, and end through illustrations and sentences. In the next week we will be exploring the characteristics of a fiction story. Students will be identifying Characters, Setting, Problem, and Solution. In addition, they will also be sharing their favourite part!

We have also been talking about vowels and listening to hear the difference between long and short sounds. This month we will be exploring the different vowel patterns found in words to support our writing.





In Math, we have been exploring numbers and place value (Grade 2 to 100, and Grade 3 to 1000). As noted in the Home Connection letter sent home last Friday, we have been learning about different ways to represent numbers. We will be moving into comparing and rounding numbers and exploring addition and subtraction strategies. We have already explored the Fact Family of 10, which will be essential in fact fluency!



In Science, Grade 2's have been learning about Simple Machines and Movement. Grade 3's have been learning about Structures and what makes them strong and sturdy.

Within the next few weeks, students will be using what they have learned in our hands-on building experiments!
