#### EARLY SCHOOL CLOSURE PROCEDURES

Our school procedures for early school closure are a little different this year. The plan is as follows:

- If our internet is working, a <u>school messenger voicemail and/or email</u> will be forwarded to all parents and/or quardians to inform you about the closure.
  - Kindergarten and grade 1 families will go to the Kindergarten doors to sign your child out
  - Grade 2 6 and Grade 6 FI families will go to the front door to sign your child out
  - Grade 7/8, Grade 7 FI and Grade 8 FI families will go to Mr. Mike's classroom door located downstairs (on Broadway) to sign your child out
  - If you have indicated that your child can walk home or take the bus on your emergency dismissal form, they will be sent home as per your instructions
  - A personal phone call will be made for students remaining at the school. These students will remain at school until we connect with each other.
- Please note that if you have more than one child within the school, you will still
  need to go the designated doors to sign each of your children out. This enables us
  to account for each child that we are dismissing.
- If our internet is not working, the staff will be using their personal or school phones to contact families and <u>all the above procedures will be followed.</u> Please note that they may be identified as "No caller ID".
