GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

Courses required for graduation BY THE END OF GRADE 12:

- 4 credits in English
- 3 credits in Mathematics
- 2 credits in Science
- 1 credit in Canadian history
- 1 credit in Canadian geography
- 1 credit in the arts
- 1 credit in health and physical education
- 1 credit in French as a second language
- 0.5 credit in Career studies
- 0.5 credit in Civics

PLUS one credit from each of the following groups*:

- **Group 1:** Additional credit in English or French, social science and the humanities or Canadian and World studies, or Guidance and career education, co-operative education**
- Group 2: Additional credit in health and physical education, French, or the arts, or business studies, co-operative
 education**
- Group 3: Additional credit in Science (grade 11 or 12) or French, or technological education, computer studies, cooperative education**
- *where a credit is already listed in the list of compulsory courses, the group fulfillment is an additional credit in that area of study
- **Co-op can only be used to complete a maximum of 2 group requirements

ADDITIONAL GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS:

- 40 hours of community involvement activities (check granderie.ca for eligible activities: granderie.ca-Programs and Learning-Graduate-Community Involvement 40 hours
- Provincial literacy requirement: OSSLT/OSSLC (Literacy Test/Course)
- 2 online courses (opt-out possible at granderie.ca -Family Supports-E-learning opt out)
