#### Paris Central Parking

As you know, parking at Paris Central is at a minimum. However, to ensure the safety of our students, please adhere to the by-laws that are in place and the signage that is at the front of the school.

- Stopping to drop your child off is allowed, only between the road signs that say, "Drop Off and Pick-Up Zone from 8 am to 5 pm."
- There is no stopping or parking south of the "Drop Off and Pick-Up Zone" sign (in front of the school sign and the front door of the school)
- 3. If you have younger children that need to be escorted to the play area, parking for approximately 10 minutes is allowed between the "Drop Off and Pick-Up Zone" signs.
- 4. There is no stopping or parking beyond this point (north end of the "Drop Off and Pick-Up Zone" sign), until you are very close to Charlotte Street, where there is room for approximately 2 cars.
- 5. There is no stopping or parking in the bus zone, in front of the two fire hydrants or in front of the crossing guard.
