What is SWAC?

dual credit program that provides **SWAC** is a senior high school students an opportunity to complete post-secondary credits on a college campus while completing their high school diploma.

SWAC allows eligible students to:

- attend up to two semesters
- complete their Ontario Secondary School Diploma requirements and
- take up to four college credits, counting towards both high school and college diplomas.

Who is eligible?

You are eligible if you are between 17 and 21 years of age. In your last year of high school, and have 20+ high school credits.



Who can apply?

To apply to a SWAC program, you must be registered with the Brant Haldimand Norfolk Catholic District School Board or the Grand Erie District School Board.

Out of school, but still need credits? Go to or call your home high school to register.

HOW DOES SWAC WORK?

SWAC Programs are delivered fulltime at Fanshawe, Simcoe; Mohawk, Ohsweken; and Conestoga, Brantford.

Each college credit component successfully completed also generates one secondary credit towards your OSSD.

You have the opportunity to earn more secondary credits if you need them.

Half of your time is dedicated to the college component; the other half is your secondary component.

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Three Easy Steps

- Talk to a guidance counsellor to see if SWAC is right for you.
- **2.** Complete an application form with help from your guidance counsellor.
- **3.** Attend an intake interview with a college professor and teacher to review your plans.
